Numerator Quality-Data Coding Options for Reporting Satisfactorily:

- Patient Screened for Tobacco Use: CPT II 4004F: Patient screened for tobacco use AND received tobacco cessation intervention (counseling, pharmacotherapy, or both), if identified as a tobacco user
- 2) Patient Screened for Tobacco Use and Identified as a Non-User of Tobacco: CPT II 1036F: Current tobacco non-user OR
 - 3) **Tobacco Screening not Performed for Medical Reasons**: Append a modifier (**1P**) to CPT Category II code **4004F** to report documented circumstances that appropriately exclude patients from the denominator **4004F** *with* **1P**: Documentation of medical reason(s) for not screening for tobacco use (eg, limited life expectancy, other medical reasons)

OR

- 4) Tobacco Screening OR Tobacco Cessation Intervention not Performed Reason Not Otherwise Specified: Append a reporting modifier (8P) to CPT Category II code 4004F to report circumstances when the action described in the numerator is not performed and the reason is not otherwise specified.
 - 4004F with 8P: Tobacco screening OR tobacco cessation intervention not performed, reason not otherwise specified
